Dallas, Texas - Tabligh Activities!

The Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, Dallas chapter was recognized at the 8th annual Unity Day USA service at Unity Church in Dallas, Texas on September 11th 2012. About 100 people gathered to remember the lives lost on 9/11 and to symbolize the importance of tolerance for all faiths and backgrounds. The Unity Day USA service honored two communities this year - the Sikh faith in the aftermath of massacre in Wisconsin and also the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community and their Muslims for Life campaign, whose goal is to collect donations of 11,000 units of blood as a September 11th remembrance. In the words of the Unity Day event coordinator, Mr. Mike Ghose, the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community was honored “for their work towards building a cohesive America.”

For the past two years the Lajna members of the Dallas chapter have worked with members of Unity Church in an interfaith club to discuss various interfaith topics. Members from the Unity Church have also attended various interfaith events held by the Dallas Lajna. Last year Unity Church also participated in the Muslims for Life campaign by holding a blood drive at their Church. Lajna hopes to continue their ongoing relationship with the women of this church and others they have met through the faith clubs.
